

ISMICT 2026 Final Paper Submission Guideline

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR IEEE XPLORE PUBLICATION

All accepted and presented papers will be submitted for publication in IEEE Xplore.

- Complete the Camera-Ready Submission Process by the deadline, including successful PDF verification through **IEEE PDF eXpress** and completion of the **IEEE Electronic Copyright Form (eCF)**.
- At least one author must complete a Full Registration. Papers not covered by a valid Full Registration will be excluded from the technical program and will not be eligible for presentation at the conference.
- At least one author must present the paper on-site at ISMICT 2026. Papers not presented in accordance with the conference presentation policy will be excluded from IEEE Xplore and other indexing services.

Opt-Out of IEEE Xplore Publication: Authors who do not wish their paper to be included in IEEE Xplore must notify the Technical Program Committee (contact@ismict2026.org) no later than 31 August 2026.

Please review all items from Sections 1 through 8 carefully. **The Final Submission process will be considered complete once you have successfully uploaded your camera-ready manuscript via EDAS as described in Section 6.**

1. Important Dates

- Camera-Ready (Final) Manuscript Submission Deadline: **31 August 2026**
- Author Registration Deadline: **31 August 2026**

2. Formatting Rules

- All papers must follow the IEEE Conference Paper Format.
- All fonts must be embedded in the PDF file.
- **Authors are required to verify their PDF files using IEEE PDF eXpress before final submission.**
- Papers that do not meet the IEEE formatting requirements may be excluded from the conference proceedings.
- Authors are strongly encouraged to carefully incorporate reviewers' comments and suggestions into the final manuscript before submission.

3. IEEE PDF eXpress

- **All papers must be verified for formatting compliance using IEEE PDF eXpress and submitted as IEEE PDF eXpress-approved PDF files.**
- Conference ID: [71751X]
- How to Use IEEE PDF eXpress: Visit IEEE PDF eXpress (<https://ieee-pdf-express.org/Account/Login>), create/login account, enter Conference ID(71751X), upload manuscript, review compliance report, revise if necessary, download approved PDF, and submit via EDAS.

4. Copyright Form

All accepted papers require completion of the **IEEE Electronic Copyright Form (eCF)**. Failure to complete the process by the deadline may result in exclusion from the proceedings and IEEE Xplore.

5. Author Registration

At least one author of each accepted paper must complete a Full Registration by the registration deadline. One Full Registration may cover up to two (2) accepted papers.

During the registration process, authors must enter the EDAS Paper ID(s) of the accepted paper(s) to be covered by the registration. The Paper ID can be found in EDAS and in the acceptance notification e-mail (e.g., #0123456789).

6. Final Submission via EDAS

Log in to EDAS, open your accepted paper record, upload the IEEE PDF eXpress-compliant PDF, verify metadata, complete copyright submission, and confirm successful upload. EDAS URL: <https://edas.info/N34873>

7. No-Show Policy

At least one author of each accepted paper is required to present the paper during the conference. Papers not presented by an author at the scheduled session will be considered no-show papers. No-show papers may be excluded from the official conference proceedings, submission to IEEE Xplore, and indexing services. Authors who are unable to attend due to exceptional circumstances should contact the Conference Organizing Committee as early as possible. The conference reserves the right to withhold publication of any paper that is not presented in accordance with the conference presentation policy. Such papers will be excluded from the conference proceedings, IEEE Xplore, and other indexing services.
